

GOED PRIVACY POLICY STATEMENT

Goed Student Financing Limited (hereinafter referred to as the “**Company**”) recognizes the importance of your privacy and the need to protect all and any personal information provided by you.

This privacy policy statement (“**Privacy Statement**”) explains how personal data is collected from www.goed.com (the “**Website**”) and the security and access of such personal Data which is all dealt with in compliance and in accordance with the **Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance (Cap 486 of the Law of Hong Kong)** (the “**Ordinance**”).

Please read this Privacy Statement carefully. Your use of the Website, and your participation in the Company’s business activities means that you have read and accepted this Privacy Policy. If you use the Website and or participate in the Company’s business activities, it indicates that you have read and understood this Privacy Statement and have agreed to how your personal Data is to be collected and used, as provided in this Privacy Statement.

The Company reserves the right to change or modify the contents of the Website at any time and has the right to unilaterally change this Privacy Statement without notification. You should regularly visit the Website to find out whether this Privacy Statement has been modified, as your continued use of the Website indicates your acceptance of any change to this Privacy Statement. "You", "your", and "users" refer to any person and/or entity that access the Website for any reason.

Collection of Data and its Purpose

The Company will acquire personal information by lawful and appropriate means, and will not collect personal information by improper means. You understand and acknowledge that personal information supplied by you is voluntary, but that without your information, we may not be able to provide the required services to you. When you use the Website and or participate in our business activities you may have to provide to the Company your personal Data, including but not limited to your name, contact details and email address (collectively the “**Data**”).

You agree and understand that any and all of the Data that you provide to the Company will be collected and used only for the Company in providing its services.

In that respect, the Company undertakes to fully comply with the following six data protection principles, as required by the Ordinance:

DPP1 - Data Collection Principle

Personal Data must be collected in a lawful and fair way, for a purpose directly related to a function /activity of the Data user. Data subjects must be notified of the purpose and the classes

of persons to whom the Data may be transferred. Data collected should be necessary but not excessive.

DPP2- Accuracy & Retention Principle

Practicable steps shall be taken to ensure personal Data is accurate and not kept longer than is necessary to fulfil the purpose for which it is used.

DPP3 - Data Use Principle

Personal Data must be used for the purpose for which the Data is collected or for a directly related purpose, unless voluntary and explicit consent with a new purpose is obtained from the Data subject.

DPP4 - Data Security Principle

A Data user needs to take practicable steps to safeguard personal Data from unauthorised or accidental access, processing , erasure, loss or use.

DPP5 - Openness Principle

A Data user must take practicable steps to make personal Data policies and practices known to the public regarding the types of personal Data it holds and how the Data is used.

DPP6 - Data Access & Correction Principle

A Data subject must be given access to his/her personal Data and allowed to make corrections if it is inaccurate.

Disclosure

You agree and understand that the Company may be required to disclose your Data if required by law, court order, or as requested by any government or law enforcement authority or administrative organization.

Security of Data

The Company will take all necessary and appropriate steps, such as protection from destruction, leakage, and modification, etc. to ensure the security of all personal information and the proper handling of all such personal information.

You understand that any website with links to the Website may collect Data. Your provision of Data to any third party has nothing to do with the Company and the Company will not have any responsibility for such Data.

Access and Correction request

Under the Ordinance, you have the right to ascertain whether we hold your personal Data, and if we do, to request for a copy of such Data and/or to request the correction of any of the Data that is inaccurate.
